

What's NEW in Mitel Live Desktop Portal Release 1.1



Expanded Phone Support

Mitel Live Desktop Portal works with Mitel 5212, 5224, 5304, 5312, 5324, 5320, 5330, 5340 and 5360 IP phones.

Note: You may need to update your firmware for Live Content Applications to work on your IP Phone. Required firmware:

- **Mitel 5360 firmware** 3.00.03.03 or higher
- **Mitel 5320/5330/5340 firmware** 01.06.03.04 or higher

More Live Content Applications

RSS List View - Lets you view any RSS feed on the phone in list format.

RSS Page View - Lets you view any RSS feed on the phone in page format showing the contents of each RSS article.

Enriched Blogging Filters Features

ShowOn: "Phone Model" - Allows you to have only the blog posts you have created for certain phone sets appear. You simply enter "ShowOn:", then the phone model(s) that you would like the posts to render to. The blog post will then only appear on the phone sets specified. Ex. ShowOn:5360 will only render the blog post on 5360 phone models.

ShowOn: "Day of the week" or "Month" or "Month day" or "Date Range" or "Time" - To have blog posts automatically appear on a phone during certain dates or times simply enter "ShowOn:", then the day of the week (ex. Mon), month (Jan), month day (ex. Feb 28), date range (ex. Apr 6- Aug 27), or time (ex. 8:00am-3:00pm) you wish your post to appear. The blog post will then only appear on the phone on the date and time specified. Ex. ShowOn:Jan 1;12:00am-1:00am will only appear on January 1, from 12:00am – 1:00am.

ShowOn:"Language" – To have blog posts automatically appear on a phone that has been programmed using a certain language, simply enter "ShowOn:", then the 2-character ISO language name (ex. en) or 2-character language –culture name (ex. en-US). The blog post will only appear on those phones programmed in the language specified. Ex. ShowOn:fr will only appear on phones programmed in French.

Increased Twitter security

When programming the Twitter application, instead of entering your username and password you will now be prompted to get a PIN from Twitter to allow Live Content Suite to access your Twitter feed.

Twitter and Twitter Search scrolling ability

The Twitter applications now support scrolling which will enable you to view more than one page of content on the phone.

Improved Weather Application Programming

When programming the weather application, instead of entering in a postal code, zip code or an air port, simply enter the name of the city in the appropriate field. There is an auto-complete drop down menu available as well if only the first few characters of the city name are entered, in which case all you have to do is select the city you wish to view.

Multilanguage Support

Live Desktop Portal gives you the ability to choose the language you wish to have displayed.

Call Forwarding

If you have multiple devices, Live Desktop Portal allows you to easily forward calls to an alternate phone.

Voice Mail

If you have your voice mail configured, you can have your messages emailed to you by configuring this in Live Desktop Portal.

Branding

If you have a branding application deployed to your Mitel Communications Director, Mitel Live Desktop Portal gives you the option to display the brand on your phone.

Multiuser Rollout

Live Content Suite 1.1 introduces the "Multi-User" page which enables an Administrator to copy the programming from one source phone to a set of target phones. Using this feature you can program a phone in a specific way, and then clone that phone's programming to one or more target phones.

Workgroup

Live Content Suite 1.1 introduces the concept of Workgroups. Administrators use Workgroups to assign a user the ability to program other phones. This functionality replaces the Key Programmer role from Live Content Suite 1.0.
